Dayton International Airport Economy Parking Lot

Phase 1 Reconstruction Now Complete

Reconstruction of the Economy Parking Lot began in April, 2017. Phase 1 of the construction is now complete and that portion of the lot has re-opened. Customers will now enjoy over 900 newly reconstructed parking spaces, and 12 ADA spaces located next to the Shuttle Bus stops. New LED lighting and overhead light pole row signage has been installed for customer safety, and to help them find where they parked.

The DAYrider Shuttle Buses continually route through the lot taking passengers to the front door of the Airport Terminal. The Overflow Lot will continue to be open providing plenty of parking spaces for visitors at the same daily rate of \$4.95. Phase II of the Economy Lot reconstruction is now underway. There are numerous signs placed on the airport to help guide customers to all available on-airport parking locations, whether it be in the \$4.95 Economy and Overflow Lots, or the Long Term Lot, Garage or Valet parking options.

The Cell Phone Wait Lot will be closed temporarily through July, while that lot and the PSA Headquarter parking lots are also renovated. The parking lot renovation is on schedule for completion by the late months of summer.
